

Luminous Mysteries of the Rosary (Prayed on Thursday)

The Baptism of the Lord- John baptizes Jesus in the Jordan River. The Lord sends down a dove with the Holy Spirit and the Trinity manifests. The sacrament of baptizing with the Holy Spirit begins.

The Wedding of Cana- At Mary's request, Jesus works his first miracle changing the water into wine at the wedding. Marriage becomes a sacrament.

The Proclamation of the Kingdom- Jesus teaches us to live our lives according to the Beatitudes. Love thy neighbor. Love thy enemies. The kingdom of Heaven is not of this world.

The Transfiguration- The Lord declares Jesus as his son high on the mountain. Jesus transfigures into a brilliantly radiant figure in front of Peter James, and John, three of his disciples.

The Institution of the Eucharist- During the Last Supper, Jesus introduces us to the Eucharist when he says, "Take this bread, and eat. This is my body. Take this wine, and drink. This is my blood. It will be shed for you in a new covenant."
