- 1. In attendance: Executive Committee officers stated above and about 10 other people attended the meeting.
- 2. Dr. Sara Bruins opened the meeting with a prayer.

- 4. Membership donor letters have gone out.

 - 1. Encourage parents and students to sign up together
 - 2. Teachers will be available as well if a student cannot get a parent to play.

 - 5. Tournament will be rain or shine.
 - 6. Volunteers are needed.

- 15. Website needs to have a list of needs/goals from Booster Club. Put volunteer needs on the website and make it simple to navigate.
