DIRECTOR'S NOTE

Welcome to our fall comedy!

The first known ballads featuring Robin Hood date back to the 14th century, and depicted the hero having a partisanship for lower classes, a particular skill in archery, a devotion to the Virgin Mary (and therefore a respect and regard for women), and a strong disdain for the Sheriff of Nottingham. The romantic derring-do of the hero and his crew, and the fight against tyranny and greed has appealed to generations for hundreds of years. My first introduction to the Robin Hood tale was the same, perhaps, as many of you: the animated Disney film from the 1960s. Since then I have enjoyed all kinds of iterations of the Merry Men of Sherwood; the third production I directed at Valley was a Robin Hood parody!

This particular take on the familiar tale and characters stood out to me because I thought it would be a wonderful choice for our student actors, it was a heartwarming and funny script, and it put a spin on the classic tale that I hadn't heard before.

THEATRE ETIQUETTE REMINDERS

- I. Turn your phone and other devices off. Anything that makes noise or creates light during the performance is distracting to the actors and other audience members. Please leave the auditorium if you have to use your phone.
- 2. Any recording or taking photography during the performance is strictly prohibited.
- 3. Be sure to take out anything with a noisy wrapper before the performance (cough drops, candies, etc.). Again, this is a distraction to the actors and your fellow audience members.
- 4. Please refrain from talking during the performance. We can hear you!!
- 5. Please wait until intermission to use the restrooms. If it's an emergency, please exit the auditorium as quietly as possible, and return to your seat at a scene break.
- 6. Show your appreciation! Applause is always welcome after a scene, act, and especially at the end of the show.
- 7. While children are welcome to the performance, please use your discretion. If you know your little one will not be able to sit through the performance without running around or crying, please do not bring them to the show.
- 8. Cast members can be met in the lobby after the show. Therefore, please do not go backstage during the performance or intermission.
- 9. Use your common sense...if a behavior would be annoying to you during a show, don't do it! Please show the same respect for the actors.
